TYPES OF ASSISTANCE WE OFFER:

Sunday Morning Community Breakfast--In July 2010 we began serving breakfast every Sunday morning at 8:00 a.m.. This effort was begun in coordination with, as well as guidance from, the Mission House. Since Sunday is the only day of the week that Mission House does not serve breakfast, we decided to offer this as a free service to the community. The Community Breakfast is open to anyone wishes to eat, provided they abide by the established rules. Failure to comply with ALL rules may result in expulsion from the property. Repeated offenses may result in permanent refusal to utilize this service.

Food Pantry--At JBCoC we offer assistance to individuals and families in need of groceries through the Food Pantry. This free service is offered to anyone in need.

Hours of Operation:

- Wednesdays 4:30 to 5:30 PM
- Fridays 2:00 to 4:00 PM

Those needing assistance must utilize the following guidelines:

- Food is available once a month per household
- An application must be filled out prior to pick up
- Everyone must show a picture ID

TYPES OF ASSISTANCE WE DO NOT OFFER:

We DO NOT offer cash assistance, bus passes, gas money, grocery cards, help with utility bills, rent, nor any other type of financial assistance. Additionally, we do not help with the purchase of medicine. Individual members MUST NOT be asked to help with the purchase of any of the above items. Anyone abusing this rule may be denied all types of assistance.
